Due to concerns for public health, to accommodate social distancing practices and the impossibility for anyone to predict the spread of the Coronavirus (COVID-19), the Montgomery County Municipal Courthouses located in New Lebanon (195 S. Clayton Rd.) and Huber Heights (6111 Taylorsville Rd.) will be closed from March 19, 2020 to April 3, 2020. With the courts re-opening on Monday, April 6, 2020. Anyone having business with the court, including scheduled court dates, should receive correspondence by certified mail, ordinary US mail or by telephone to reschedule their court dates. Only cases of a serious nature or felony preliminary hearings will be dealt with on Tuesday's.

The courthouses will re-open on the date indicated above unless further notice is posted.
